JEFF DeGRAFF, "THE DEAN OF INNOVATION," TO BE A FEATURED SPEAKER AT NETWORK FOR JEWISH HUMAN SERVICE AGENCY'S 2018 INAUGURAL CONFERENCE

March 10, 2018 [Paramus, NJ] – The Network of Jewish Human Service Agencies (NJHSA) announced today that Jeff DeGraff, often called the Dean of Innovation, will be a featured speaker at its 2018 Conference: Unifying Our Human Service Voice. To be held in **Chicago, IL, April 29 to May 1, 2018**, the conference's core themes are innovation, advocacy, best practices and collaboration.

"We are delighted that Jeff, a leader in driving organizational change through innovation, is speaking at our inaugural conference," said Reuben Rotman, CEO of NJHSA, the leading voice for Jewish human service agencies in the US, Canada and Israel. "Jeff's insights and creative and direct take on making innovation happen will be invaluable to both our members' work and the development of the Network's Center for Innovation and Research."

Another featured speaker is **David Axelrod**, Senior Political Commentator, CNN, and Host, The Axe Files; Director, University of Chicago Institute of Politics; and Obama's Chief Campaign Strategist and Senior Advisor to President Barack Obama (2009-2011). He will address advocacy today.

Jeff DeGraff is an advisor to Fortune 500 companies and a professor at the University of Michigan's Ross School of Business, where he created the innovations institute <u>Innovatrium</u>. His simultaneously creative and pragmatic approach to innovation has led clients and colleagues to dub him the "Dean of Innovation." In his new book, *The Innovation Code: The Creative Power of Constructive Conflict*, published in July 2017, he shows how to harness conflicts to create something better and new.
