As an international membership association, the Network today includes member agency representation from throughout the United States, Canada and Israel. With over 140 member agencies, and growing, who together provide comprehensive human services for the Jewish community and beyond, Network member agencies have established a continuum of care addressing complex and changing needs, including healthcare, career, employment and mental health services, as well as services for youth, families and caregivers, seniors, Holocaust survivors, immigrants and refugees and persons with disabilities.

The Network has established four core pillars which guide its service delivery; advocacy, innovation, best practices and collaboration. Through its Center for Innovation and Research, the Network works with its member agencies to identify innovative responses to challenges and establishes partnerships with corporations, government, foundations, philanthropists and universities.
