

Title: Social Services Manager, Jewish Care Program, Santa Fe Office

The Jewish Care Program (JCP) is a program of the Jewish Federation of New Mexico. JCP is dedicated to the well-being of our most vulnerable community members, moving them from isolation to connection.

The Social Services Manager manages the care and support services offered through the Santa Fe office, and is an essential part of the JCP team. Services addressed by this position include:

- Outreach and ongoing support to isolated Jewish seniors
- Support group facilitation
- Connection to much needed resources for families and individuals
- Volunteer management
- Project management

The Social Worker position is part time (20-24 hrs/week) and is under the direction and supervision of the Director of the Jewish Care Program. This position will be located in Santa Fe.

3-5 years' experience in related field required. Master's degree in social work or related field strongly preferred. Knowledge of Santa Fe community resources and the Jewish community is a plus. Must have a valid driver license and in some cases, use one's own vehicle, to visit clients and do community outreach. Rate of pay: \$18.00 - \$21.00 per hour based on experience. The Jewish Federation of New Mexico offers an excellent part-time benefit package including: Dental/Vision insurance, paid time off (holiday, vacation & personal/sick), reimbursement of malpractice insurance costs, and up to \$500 per year reimbursement for clinical supervision costs.
