Requires: Current license as LCSW, LPC or LMFT in Colorado and two to five years' experience in individual, group, family, and couples therapy; familiarity with DSM V and diagnostic techniques; knowledge of Medicaid compliance requirements, helpful; effective written and verbal communication skills; proficiency with Word and using electronic health records; able to work approximately 4 evening hours per week.

Prefer EMDR trained clinicians, or alternate certification.

All mental health clinicians must register with CAQH within 7 days of hire date.
