- Coordinate, schedule, and facilitate individual and family therapy sessions to address clients' emotional, mental, and social well-being and as outlined in the treatment plan.
- Provide counseling/consultation services at Jewish and secular schools, local synagogues, JCC and other Jewish agencies.
- Conduct crisis intervention as needed.

Compensation and Schedule

This position is part time, 20 hours/week. Depending upon community need and funding sources this may become a regular full-time position. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience of the selected candidate.

- Licensed Clinical Social Worker or Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist
- Experience providing individual and family therapy
- Experience providing specialized therapy (trauma informed therapy, DBT, CBT)

- Comfortable with face-to-face as well as telehealth services.
