Full time clinical psychologist needed to join the JFS diagnostic evaluation team. The position will provide testing for students enrolled in the Jewish schools in Dallas and will operate out of our main office located at Arapaho and the Dallas North Tollway.

Specialized training and experience in Autism Spectrum Disorders, complex learning disabilities and working with schools are required, as well as, experience in providing competency, skill building techniques, counseling and supportive resources to special needs children and families and attending school feedback meetings. Doctoral degree (Ph.D or Psy.D) in Clinical Psychology is required. Licensed as a Clinical Psychologist by the State of Texas is ideal, but will consider Provisionally Licensed Psychologists. Minimum 3 years diagnostic assessment experience with children and adolescents. Supervisory experience a plus.
