



Two Adults, Two Children

Sylvia and Homero are parents of two children, both in elementary school. The children go to YES Prep about 8 miles from their home. Homero is a bus driver and Sylvia is a home care worker. Sylvia picks up extra hours sometimes. The children take piano lessons. During COVID, even with support from the school, the family's budget for technology was strained as the family added devices and internet capacity so the children could go to school remotely. Fortunately, the grandmother was able to help out with childcare during that time, although Homero was often home as his hours were cut. Homero was able to keep his benefits but his pay was cut. When fully employed, their two salaries almost reach their survival budget.


